Dear Reader;

This is an open letter to anyone that is interested in listening. First, I will present some facts and the present my views, and finally comments.

Facts:

- Just because a person is a Moslem, it does not make them a terrorist.
- America's point of view is not being presented to the Moslem communities in any shape or form.
- Americans are not being told the truth about what our State Department, CIA, and Big Business are doing in the Third World.
- American's do not understand the Moslem communities at all, they have never tried to understand, and they are actually still fighting the Crusade.
- The words "Islam" and "Moslem" are subjective terms, both are miss-used and miss-understood.

About Me:

I am a tenth or eleventh generation American, my family came to this country between 1730 to 1750. I have relatives that were in the Revolutionary War (on both sides, sorry to say). My roots come from Europe (England, Ireland, Germany, Spain, and Denmark). I have been trained from childhood as a Lutheran, Baptist, Catholic, LDS, and Methodist, not necessarily in that order. I have studied all my life for the truth. I began reading the Quran in 1985 while teaching the Saudi Arabian Military in electronics. My Views:

Therefore there are many Submitters and they are not all Arabs. They are of many cultures, faiths, and ethnic backgrounds.

The Nation of Abraham is not a sect of Islam. The Nation of Abraham is the religion of God. All people, Christian, Jews, Moslems, Buddhist, or what ever name you use. If you believe in One God, and worship One God, do not associate partners with God, believe in the unseen, and the hereafter, and try to live your life in the best possible manor as dictated by the Scriptures, you are a member of the Nation of Abraham.

I take great exception to the News Media using the term "Moslem Terrorist".
